Personal reflection questions:

How was your time in the Word this week?

What is something God is teaching you either through the Word or in this book?

Book reflection questions:

What is something that challenged you in this chapter?

What is something that encouraged you?

How was slavery in the Bible very different from the slavery in America? (i.e: Biblical slavery was not rooted in race)

What scriptures can you think of that speak about the equality of humanity?

How can you acknowledge hurt in conversations surrounding slavery without being defensive?

Is there anything you need to do after reading this chapter?

Pray for each person in your group individually/follow up on past requests.
