

Women's Study Small Group Leaders Guide -Chapter 11

Our hope is that these questions would help guide your time together. Aim for an hour to an hour and a half of intentional conversation about the chapter, how each girl is doing personally and a time to pray for each person in your group.

Personal reflection questions:

How was your time in the Word this week?

Who are you seeking to share the gospel with and how is that going?

What is something God is teaching you either through the Word or in this book?

Book reflection questions:

What is something that challenged you in this chapter?

What is something that encouraged you?

Do you struggle with this idea of how can a loving God allow suffering? Are there any scriptures or thoughts that have helped you grapple with this concept?

How has your understanding of the gospel (God is sovereign and God holds people responsible for their sin) helped shape your worldview of suffering?

How does the gospel provide hope to those who are suffering?

Is there anything you need to do after reading this chapter?

Pray for each person in your group individually/follow up on past requests.
