

Women's Study Small Group Leaders Guide -Chapter 12

Our hope is that these questions would help guide your time together. Aim for an hour to an hour and a half of intentional conversation about the chapter, how each girl is doing personally and a time to pray for each person in your group.

Personal reflection questions:

How was your time in the Word this week?

Who are you seeking to share the gospel with and how is that going?

What is something God is teaching you either through the Word or in this book?

Book reflection questions:

What is something that challenged you in this chapter?

What is something that encouraged you?

How does God's judgment in sending people to hell reinforce God's holiness?

When you rephrase the statement *how could a loving God send people to hell as how could a holy God let sinful people into heaven* change your perspective?

How would you have a respectful conversation with a peer who asked this question? (i.e. we're all sinful, no one "deserves" heaven)

Now that you've read the whole book, what is one major take away?

Pray for each person in your group individually/follow up on past requests.
