Our hope is that these questions would help guide your time together. Aim for an hour to an hour and a half of intentional conversation about the chapter, how each girl is doing personally and a time to pray for each person in your group.

Personal reflection questions:

How was your time in the Word this week?

Who are you seeking to share the gospel with and how is that going?

What is something God is teaching you either through the Word or in this book?

Book reflection questions:

What is something that challenged you in this chapter?

What is something that encouraged you?

What did you think of the elephant paradigm?

How would you respond if someone said, "Jesus demanding allegiance from all humans is offensive"?

Can you think of a time when a friend challenged your beliefs? What did that conversation look like? Were you flattered or offended by their challenges? (page 49)

Is there anything you need to do after reading this chapter?

Pray for each person in your group individually/follow up on past requests.
